Summer Class Info

- There is no leotard color requirement for summer classes.
- Dancers should arrive in a leotard, tights and ballet slippers if possible.
- Hair should be pulled back and in a bun for levels 2A and higher.

Fall Registration Day

Registration Day is Friday, August 17th from 2:00-6:30pm

Stop in and take advantage of all the tuition discounts, purchase dance attire and get sized for your fall leotard. We will have all items in stock; but if we don't have your size by the time you drop in, we will be placing an order and everyone will have their items in time for the first week of classes.

Classes will be available for online registration July 30th. We highly recommend you do this to ensure a spot in your preferred class, however you can take care of your registration at the studio as well. We will have laptops available for you to do that.

Fall Dress Code Information

Our Dress Code will remain the same as it was last year. Leotards MUST be purchased through MBC, but tights and shoes can be purchased elsewhere. We do encourage you to purchase those through us as we sell the styles we prefer the dancers to have.

We will have discounts on shoes and tights on Registration Day ONLY!!!

Our process for participating in *The Nutcracker* has changed slightly.

1. Nutcracker Informational meeting is on **Friday August 17th at 6:30pm.**
2. Parents of dancers are REQUIRED to sign up for at least one volunteer position.
3. Dancers MUST be enrolled in Ballet 1A or higher this fall to participate.
4. Dancers will be split cast.
5. Make sure to check the Performance Agreement if you can perform in the New Ulm performances. More information provided at the meeting.

Only sign your Performance Agreement if you plan to fully participate and are available for all the rehearsals and performances.

FALL TUITION DISCOUNTS

If you register and pay your annual tuition in full you will receive a 10% discount.
(Must be paid by Cash or Check ONLY.)

If you have multiple family members enrolling you pay the full tuition for the most advanced student and then get 10% off all other family members.

If you are enrolled in ballet classes and wish to take a supplementary class you will get 20% off your supplementary classes.

Boys pay the Registration Fee and the remainder of their tuition is FREE through level 1B. Boys in 2A and higher will each receive a \$700 scholarship towards their ballet tuition. (No refunds of this scholarship are allowed.)
