At this time, MBC has decided to implement mandatory masks for everyone over the age of 5 who enters the facility, including during classes and rehearsals.

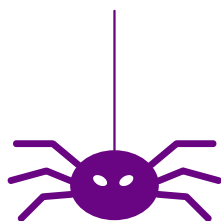
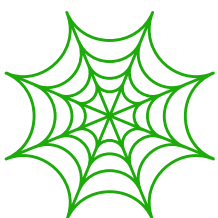
ADD A CLASS
